Hopefully you are looking forward to the new season, its not far away now and see you down the club soon.





Happy New Year and welcome to the 2024 sailing season with a new Executive Committee. Those who attended the AGM will be aware I moved from Sailing Secretary to Vice Commodore. My Sailing Secretary role has been filled by Stuart Cox.

As Vice Commodore, my role sits somewhere between Commodore and Sailing Secretary, so I will have to be careful not to duplicate any of Gary or Stuart's reports. As well as project managing Open events and liaising with other clubs, I will also be chairing the Sailing Committee meetings.

If you have any ideas or suggestions to offer, please do get in touch with either Stuart or me.

Stuart and I have been busy producing the 2024 sailing calendar and it is now on the website, ready to be viewed. As with any calendar produced at the beginning of the season, it is subject to minor adjustment along the way, so please do keep an eye out for changes.

We are continuing with last year's 10.30am start with, three back-toback races for series races. Trophy Races will be two races in the morning, two races in the afternoon, with a short lunch break in between.

One addition to the calendar we are planning is hosting a Europe Open in April. Details are still being finalised, but it will be on either the 21st or 28th April. It will run alongside our Sunday racing, but we will give the Europes a head start, er I mean a separate start... If you have a Europe, please do support the event and join in. Chris Corke, can you get yours fixed in time? The event will require all four safety boats to be on the water and Dave Boniface's Wild Goose will be a committee boat. We will require lots of roles filled, including Beach Crews in wet gear, Lap Recorders and Safety Boat Helms/Crews. Please do volunteer for duties as soon as Adam has posted them on DutyMan. Lap Recorders are a good duty to undertake, it involves recording the sail numbers of the boats as they complete a lap and cross the finish line. The bonus being you get to do it from the comfort of Wild Goose.

We are hosting a BLAZE Open in September, with a view to hosing a Nationals next year. The BLAZE and Europe are the only Open events we are hosting this year.

In the next few weeks, we will be meeting the other Federation Clubs again, to discuss this year's Federation Cup, which is to be hosted by Bexhill Sailing Club. Following the meeting the Commodore or I will give you an update. You may have seen my post on Facebook, offering assistance signing up to WebCollect. We had a session a weeks ago, there was only 1 taker but it was early in the renewal window. It may be suggestive that the membership is happy with WebCollect, if not, my offer stands. Lucy and I will be at the club again on Sunday 10th March.

You will be aware we have been having problems with the VHF base station radios in the Race Box. Dave Watson kindly assisted me and we identified the two problems. The main radio's antenna cable had been cut off, possibly during some maintenance early last year. The protective sleeving on back-up radio's antenna cable was fractured and weather had got into the cable. Goff has kindly purchased two new antennas and they will be fitted in the next couple of weeks.

Allen Hare and Steve Jobling have been assisting me get the weather station data displayed on our website. This is still work in progress, but once complete it will benefit members who live further afield.

Finally, those of you sailing the winter series at Bough Beech, I wish you fair weather, those not braving the cold waters, hopefully I will see at a closed season social or one of Goff's work parties.
