## **Paddle Sports - Conditions of Membership - 2022**

### **MEMBERSHIP**

Membership of Pevensey Bay Sailing Club runs from 1 January to 31 December of each year. Paddle Sports members may try sailing on three occasions after which 'Sailing plus Paddle Sports' membership is required. 'Paddle Sports' membership may be changed to 'Sailing plus Paddle Sports' by paying the difference in annual renewal fees.

### **INSURANCE**

All paddle craft must, while at Pevensey Bay Sailing Club (hereafter referred to as the Club), be fully insured for third party cover with minimum cover of £2,000,000.

The Club has full Public Liability Insurance with minimum cover of £3,000,000.

### **MEMBERS' CRAFT AND EQUIPMENT**

Any paddle craft or personal equipment at the Club is there entirely at the owner's risk. The Club cannot be held responsible for any loss or damage that may occur.

The Club has installed active video cameras and has a code protected entry gate.

### **CLUB EQUIPMENT**

Using any equipment belonging to the Club is done so entirely at your own risk.

The Club makes regular Health and Safety checks and provides members with a process to report any concerns.

### **CHILDREN / JUNIOR MEMBERS**

Each child registered as a member of the Club must have their parents' consent. In accordance with club regulations, you agree to provide an approved buoyancy aid for each child intent on water-based activities. You agree to be responsible for your registered child's good conduct whilst on Club premises and/or taking part in Club activities. You also agree not to hold the Club liable for any accident or other difficulty in which any such child may become involved. The Club has a nominated Child Welfare Officer and a Child Protection Policy.

### **PHOTOGRAPHS AND VIDEOS**

During the sailing season it is likely that adult and junior members will be photographed or videoed during training, regattas and social events - including by third parties or press. It is Club policy that, unless indicated otherwise on your membership form, these photos and videos will be used as the Club sees fit; this may include photos on the Club wall, in publicity documents, on the website, on Facebook and on other social media.

## **DUTIES**

The Club is a non-profit making organisation run by its members for its members. Therefore for the efficient running of the Club it is essential that all members do their duties. On the membership form there is a space for you to indicate how confident or competent you are for some specific tasks; all inexperienced members will be given support to enable them to do their duty in whatever form that may take. Duties are usually advertised in March for the whole season ahead. If members cannot attend a programmed duty, it is their responsibility to find a replacement. Usually members are planned for an average of three duties per year, but can volunteer to do more should they wish to do so.

The Club uses the on-line Dutyman system to help plan and swap duties where needed accessible via the Club website.

## **CLUB RULES AND REGULATIONS**

This application or renewal is made on the basis of the Club Regulations and Sailing Instructions both of which are available on the Club website. Other than the Club safety boats, only paddle boards and kayaks may be launched from Club premises with paddle sports membership.

## **DATA PRIVACY**

The information you provide on the membership form will be used solely for dealing with you as a member of Pevensey Bay Sailing Club.

The Club has a Data Privacy Policy. Your data will be stored and used in accordance with this policy.

The Club may arrange for photographs or videos to be taken of Club activities and published on our website, social media channels or the press to promote the Club.

Your consent to your image being used in this way is requested on the first page of the membership form. Your partner's consent is also requested for 'Family' and 'Couple' memberships. Your PARENTAL/GUARDIAN CONSENT is also requested for children under 18 included in 'Family' memberships. If you or any of the individuals listed above later wish to withdraw consent, please contact the Club's membership secretary. By agreeing to your images being used, you agree to assign any copyright or any other right of ownership of these images to the Club.
