



Introduction

Pevensey Bay Sailing Club is dedicated to fostering the growth and development of young sailors within our club. Recognising the financial challenges youth sailors may face when participating in events away from their home club, we propose the establishment of a Youth Sailor Bursary. This initiative aims to alleviate some financial burdens associated with participating in such events, enabling more young sailors to pursue their passion for competitive sailing.

Bursary Details

The Youth Sailor Bursary will provide financial assistance to youth sailors who are members of Pevensey Bay Sailing Club and wish to participate in sailing events held away from their home club. The bursary will cover up to half of the entry fees incurred by the selected applicants. The value of the available bursary fund in any one calendar year is £1000. For the 2024 season, a club member has kindly offered to match the club's funding taking the total available bursary for the 2024 season to £2000. Bursary awards will be capped at a maximum of £250 for any one individual per calendar year.

Eligibility Criteria

1. Applicants must be active members of Pevensey Bay Sailing Club in good standing.
2. Applicants must be youth sailors defined by the club constitution from up to the age of 25 years old.
3. Applicants must provide evidence of their participation in the sailing event(s) for which they seek financial assistance.
4. Applicants must provide evidence of the fee(s) for which they seek financial assistance.
5. The applicant can claim a maximum of 50% of an event's entry fee, travel and accommodation.
6. Only one claim per boat per event will be accepted.
7. Preference may be given to applicants demonstrating financial need, commitment to the sport of sailing, and potential for personal and/or athletic growth.

Application Process

Interested youth sailors must submit a completed application form, including details of the event(s) they wish to participate in, along with supporting documentation such as event registration confirmation and a brief statement outlining their financial need and reasons for seeking the bursary.

The executive committee will review the application at the next meeting (Meetings generally occur on the first Friday of every month). A decision will be given within 7 days of the meeting date. Applicants will be notified of the committee's decision in writing.



Following a successful application, applicants must enter the event and supply evidence of payment to the club treasurer for reimbursement.

In the event that an event is cancelled and the applicant receives a refund, an amount equal to 50% of the refund value must be returned to the club.

Discretion of the Executive Committee

The allocation of bursary funds will be at the discretion of the executive committee of Pevensey Bay Sailing Club. The committee will review all applications received and determine the eligibility of applicants based on the established criteria. In the event that the total value of eligible applications exceeds the available bursary fund, the executive committee reserves the right to prioritise applicants based on the aforementioned criteria.

Conclusion

Establishing the Youth Sailor Bursary underscores PBSC's commitment to supporting the competitive development of young sailors who are the future of the sport and the Sailing Club. This initiative will benefit individual sailors and contribute to our sailing community's overall growth and vibrancy.
